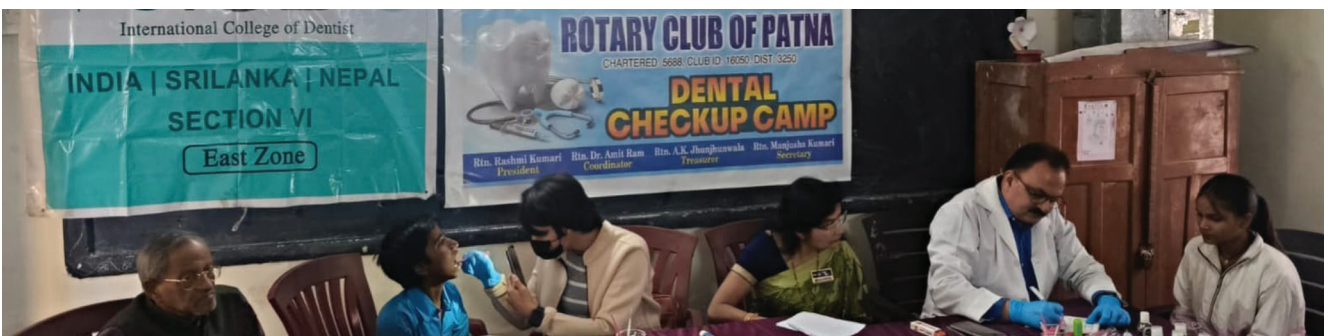

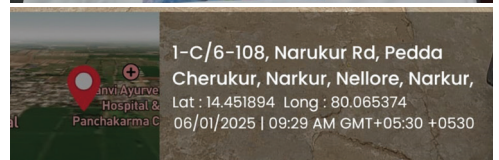
International Women's Day
